The Crown's menu changes regularly, depending on what our chefs have brought in fresh that morning, however, we do always keep a few of our house favourites on the menu.

Breakfast is served from 8:00am until 10:00am, offering both tasty full English breakfasts and lighter, continental options.

Our restaurant is open daily and serves lunch from noon until 3:00pm and dinner from 6:00pm until 9:00pm.Being a proud member of the Adnams family, we serve a wide range of Adnams beers, wines and spirits including seasonal specials and collaboration beers.

The nearest train station to The Crown is Darsham or Halesworth both of which are approximately a 20-minute drive away. Taxi services in and around Southwold are limited therefore we urge you to provide plenty of notice.

#### FIRE PRECAUTIONS - IMPORTANT

We recommend you familiarise yourself with the emergency procedures in the event of a fire such as exit routes and alarm breakpoints. The restaurant and rooms are equipped with a fire detection system; should you hear the alarm please evacuate immediately and gather at the Fire Assembly point located in the carpark and await further instruction.

You are not permitted to smoke inside any part of the building including your guestroom. Should you wish to smoke, please do so in designated outside areas only.

We accept all major credit and debit cards except AMEX. Please note that cheques are no longer accepted as a method of payment.
